

Encryptics Privacy Policy

(Last Revised: March 15, 2016)

This Online and Mobile Privacy Policy ("**Privacy Policy**") explains how information is collected, used and disclosed by Encryptics, LLC ("**Encryptics**"), and applies to information we collect when you use or access our online or mobile websites (<http://encryptics.com> and <http://encryptics.net>), products, services or applications (collectively, the "**Encryptics Services**"), or when you otherwise interact with us. We respect the privacy rights of users and recognize the importance of protecting information collected about you. If you use the Encryptics Services as part of an entity or organization that has an agreement with Encryptics (like your employer or a university), the terms of that organization's contract for the Encryptics Services may restrict our collection or use of your information more than what is described in this Policy.

1 Changes to This Policy

We may change this Privacy Policy from time to time. If we make any changes, we will notify you by revising the "Last Updated" date at the top of this Privacy Policy and, in some cases, we may provide you with additional notice (such as adding a statement to our homepage or sending you an email notification). If there are material changes to this Privacy Policy, we will notify you more directly by email or means of a notice on the home page prior to the change becoming effective. We encourage you to review our Privacy Policy whenever you access the Encryptics Services to stay informed about our information practices and the ways you can help protect your privacy. Your use of any of the Encryptics Services after the posting of such changes shall constitute your consent to such changes.

2 Information Collected

2.1 Information You Provide To Us

We collect information you provide directly to us.

- For example, we collect information when you register with Encryptics for an account, create or modify your profile and online account, access and use the Encryptics Services, participate in any interactive features of the Encryptics Services, participate in a survey, contest, promotion, sweepstakes, activity or event, make a purchase, apply for a job, request customer support, communicate with us via third-party social media sites or otherwise communicate with us.
- The types of information we may collect directly from you include your name, username, email address, postal address, phone number, information about your data encryption preferences, employer's name, job title, transactional information (including services purchased or subscribed to and billing address) as well as any contact or other information you choose to provide. We also store metadata on the files or other information that you provide to the Encryptics Services ("**Metadata**") in order to be able to provide you with the features and functionality of the Encryptics Service. ENCRYPTICS DOES NOT CAPTURE OR ACCESS THE ACTUAL CONTENT YOU ARE CHOOSING TO ENCRYPT AND DECRYPT.

2.2 Information We Collect Automatically When You Use the Encryptics Services

When you access or use the Encryptics Services, we may automatically collect information about you, EXCLUDING THE ACTUAL CONTENT YOU ARE CHOOSING TO ENCRYPT AND DECRYPT, including:

- Usage Information: We monitor user activity in connection with the Encryptics Services and may collect information about the applications and features you use, the websites you visit, the sizes and names of the files you download or access while using the Encryptics Services, the Metadata you access and any actions taken in connection with the access and use of your Metadata in the Encryptics Services.
- Log Information: We log information about you when you access and use the Encryptics Services including your Internet Protocol ("IP") address, access times, browser type and language, Internet Service Provider ("ISP"), the web pages that you visit, the Metadata you use and the URL of the Web page you visited before navigating to the Encryptics Services.
- Device Information: If you access the Encryptics Services from a mobile device, we collect information about the device, including the hardware model, operating system and version, unique device identifiers, mobile network information (as allowed by the mobile network) or platform information (as allowed by the specific platform type).
- Information Collected by Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies: We use various technologies to collect information, which may include saving cookies to your computer or mobile device. Cookies are small data files stored on your hard drive or in device memory that help us to improve the Encryptics Services and your experience, customize your experience and preferences, allow you to access and use the Encryptics Services without re-entering your member ID and/or password, understand which areas and features of the Encryptics Services are most popular and count visits. We may also collect information using web beacons (also known as "tracking pixels"). Web beacons are electronic images (also called "gifs") that may be used in the Encryptics Services or in emails that help us to deliver cookies, count visits, understand usage and campaign effectiveness and determine whether an email has been opened and acted upon. For more information about cookies and how to disable them, please see "Your Choices" below.
- Third party cookies: the use of cookies by third parties you may sign-in from into the Encryptics Services and/or third party applications, is not covered by our privacy policy. We do not have access or control over such cookies.
- Third Party clear gifs: Our third party partners may employ clear gifs (a.k.a. Web Beacons/Web Bugs), images, and scripts that help them better manage content on our site. We do not tie the information gathered to our Customers' or Users' personal information.

2.3 Information We Collect From Other Sources

We may also obtain information from third parties and combine that with information we collect through the Encryptics Services. For example, we may have access to certain information from a third-party social media service if you create or log into your online account through the service or otherwise provide us with access to information from the service. Any access that we may have to such information from a third-party social media service is in accordance with the authorization procedures determined by the social media service.

3 Use of Information

We may use the information we collect about you for a variety of purposes, including to:

- Provide, operate, maintain and improve the Encryptics Services;
- Enable you to access and use the Encryptics Services;
- Send you technical notices, updates, security alerts and support and administrative messages;
- Provide and deliver the services and features you request, process and complete transactions, and send you related information, including purchase confirmations and invoices;
- Respond to your comments, questions, and requests and provide customer service and support;
- Communicate with you about services, features, surveys, newsletters, offers, promotions, contests and events, and provide other news or information about Encryptics and our select partners;
- Process and deliver contest or sweepstakes entries and rewards;
- Monitor and analyze trends, usage, and activities in connection with the Encryptics Services and for marketing or advertising purposes;
- Investigate and prevent fraudulent transactions, unauthorized access to the Encryptics Services, and other illegal activities;
- Personalize and improve the Encryptics Services, and provide content, features, and/or advertisements that match your interests and preferences or otherwise customize your experience on the Encryptics Services;
- Link or combine with other information we receive from third parties to help understand your needs and provide you with better service;
- Enable you to communicate, collaborate, and share files with users you designate; and
- For other purposes about which we notify you.

4 Processing

By accessing or using the Encryptics Services or otherwise providing information to us, you consent to the processing and transfer of information in and to the U.S. and other countries and territories, which may have different privacy laws from your country of residence. ENCRYPTICS DOES NOT CAPTURE OR ACCESS THE ACTUAL CONTENT YOU ARE CHOOSING TO ENCRYPT AND DECRYPT.

5 Sharing and Disclosure of Information

We will not share personal information about you with any third parties except as described in this Privacy Policy or in connection with the Encryptics Services. ENCRYPTICS DOES NOT CAPTURE OR ACCESS THE ACTUAL CONTENT YOU ARE CHOOSING TO ENCRYPT AND DECRYPT. For example, we may share personal information about you including as follows:

- Vendors, Consultants and Other Service Providers: We may share your information with third-party vendors, consultants and other service providers who are working on our behalf and require access to your information to carry out that work, such as to process billing, provide customer support, etc.
- Corporate Account: If you are an individual Encryptics registered user and the domain of the primary email address associated with your Encryptics account is owned by your employer and was assigned to you as an employee of that organization, and such organization wishes to establish an Encryptics corporate account, then certain information concerning past use of your individual account may become accessible to that organization's administrator including your email address.
- Third Party Applications: Encryptics may provide you with opportunities to connect with third-party applications or services. If you choose to use any such third-party applications or services, we may share information about you including your username and any metadata you choose to use in connection with those applications and services, and such third parties may contact you directly as necessary. This Privacy Policy does not apply to your use of such third-party applications and services, and we are not responsible for how those third parties collect, use and disclose your information. We encourage you to review the privacy policies of those third parties before connecting to or using their applications or services to learn more about their information and privacy practices.
- Compliance with Laws: We may disclose your information to a third party if (a) we believe that disclosure is reasonably necessary to comply with any applicable law, regulation, legal process or governmental request, (b) to enforce our agreements, policies and Terms of Service, (c) to protect the security or integrity of the Encryptics Services, (d) to protect Encryptics, our customers or the public from harm or illegal activities, or (e) to respond to an emergency which we believe in the good faith requires us to disclose information to assist in preventing the death or serious bodily injury of any person.
- Business Transfers: We may share or transfer your information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company.
- Aggregated or Anonymized Data: We may also share aggregated or anonymized information with third parties that do not directly identify you.

6 Security

While no service is completely secure, Encryptics takes reasonable measures to help protect information about you from loss, theft,

misuse and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction. For example, sensitive information such as the password that we request from you on the Encryptics Services is protected with encryption, such as Secured Socket Layer (SSL) protocol, during transmission over the Internet.

The servers on which personal information is stored are kept in a controlled environment with limited access. While we take reasonable efforts to guard personal information we knowingly collect directly from you, no security system is impenetrable.

You may access your account information and our service only through the use of an individual user ID and password. To protect the confidentiality of personal information, you must keep your password confidential and not disclose it to any other person. Please advise us immediately if you believe your password has been misused. In addition, always logout and close your application when you finish your session. Please note that we will never ask you to disclose your password in an unsolicited phone call or email.

7 Your Choices

7.1 Account Information & Retention

You may update, correct or delete information about you at any time by logging into your online account and modifying your information or by emailing us at support@encryptics.com. We will retain your personal information for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy. If you wish to deactivate your account, please email us at support@encryptics.com, but note that we may retain certain information as required by law or for legitimate business purposes. We may also retain cached or archived copies of information about you for a certain period of time. We will respond to your access request within 30 days. To request removal of your personal information from our blog or testimonials, contact us at the email address listed above. In some cases, we may not be able to remove your personal information, in which case we will let you know if we are unable to do so and why.

We will retain your information for as long as your account is active or as needed to provide you services. We will retain and use your information to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes and enforce our agreements.

7.2 Promotional and Newsletter Communications

You may opt out of receiving promotional and newsletter emails from Encryptics by following the opt-out instructions provided in those emails. You may also opt-out of receiving promotional emails and other promotional communications from us at any time by emailing support@encryptics.com with your specific request. If you opt out, we may still send you non-promotional communications, such as security alerts and notices related to your access to or use of the Encryptics Services or those about your online account or our ongoing business relations.

7.3 Cookies

Most web browsers are set to accept cookies by default. If you prefer, you can usually choose to set your browser to remove or

reject browser cookies or to prompt you before accepting such a cookie. Please note that, if you choose to remove or reject browser cookies, this could affect the availability or functionality of the Encryptics Services.

7.4 California Residents

Under California law, California Residents who have an established business relationship with Encryptics may choose to opt out of Encryptics disclosure of personal information about them to third parties for direct marketing purposes. If you choose to opt-out at any time after granting approval, email support@encryptics.com.

8 Social Media Features and Widgets

Our Web site may include Social Media Features, such as the Facebook Like button [and Widgets, such as the Share this button or interactive mini-programs that run on our site]. These Features may collect your IP address, which page you are visiting on our site, and may set a cookie to enable the Feature to function properly. Social Media Features and Widgets are either hosted by a third party or hosted directly on our Site. Your interactions with these Features are governed by the privacy policy of the company providing it.

9 Blogs

Our Web site offers publicly accessible blogs or community forums. You should be aware that any information you provide in these areas might be read, collected, and used by others who access them.

10 Testimonials

We display personal testimonials of satisfied customers on our site in addition to other endorsements. With your consent we may post your testimonial along with your name.

11 Links to Third Party Websites

We may place links on the Encryptics Services. When you click on a link to a third party website from our website, your activity and use on the linked website is governed by that website's policies, not by those of Encryptics. We encourage you to visit their websites and review their privacy and user policies.

12 Our Policy Toward Children

The Encryptics Services is not directed to individuals under 13. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If you become aware that a child has provided us with personal information, please contact us at support@encryptics.com. If we become aware that a child under 13 has provided us with personal information, we will take steps to delete such information.
